I watch as Abraham leaves everything he ever knew to take a journey without knowing the destination. I see Moses crossing the Red Sea and Joshua marching around the fortified walls of Jericho. I read about Gideon fighting a massive army with 300 men and David's decisive win over Goliath. I consider how the disciples of Jesus were able to be so effective as

"ordinary,



uneducated men" and how Paul, transformed as he was, engaged the Gentile world experiencina miracle after miracle. But I also discovered when the lack of faith held back the work of God. Even Jesus was limited (somehow) by the lack of faith among his family and friends. (Matt. 13:58)


