Isaiah 43 tells us. "Do not remember the former things, nor consider the things of old. See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it?"

Do we really understand the opportunity we have right before us? Do we see the future through God's eyes?

There's precedent! Jesus always was looking to move people forward, to lead them into new life, to introduce them to new thinking and a life that can be transformed into something new. He gave sight to the blind. healed the lame and raised the dead. Talk about new things!

He taught in ways that introduced new ways of thinking, beyond the status quo, beyond the traditional. He confronted when
